Regularly attend clinical workshops to hone my practical skills. Summary of recent events include:

- First Aid workshop conducted by Red Cross Society (July 2016): Focused on skills to provide immediate care for suddenly ill or injured person in situations like RTAs, fire, drowning, cardiac arrest, seizures.
- Help Baby Breathe- Pediatrics (2014-15): Focus on the "Golden Period" first 60 seconds post labor. Learnt how to prepare the labor room for receiving the baby, oral and nasal suctioning, physical stimulation of baby, bag and mask resuscitation, chest compressions and finally call for help and continue bag and mask for higher level of resuscitation if baby still does not breathe.
- ECG Workshop (2014-15): ECG workshop included topics- fundamentals of ECG, ECG changes in myocardial infarction, heart blocks, WPW syndrome, arrhythmias, valvular lesions and cardiac failure.

• Life Support Skills- Medicine (2014-15): Basic and Advanced Life Support Skills Workshop included Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation, intubation and procedure to defibrillate the heart.
